Entries received after the deadline will NOT be considered.
Winners will be announced on Earth Day, April 22, 2017.

Guidelines & Rules

General

- Participants must live in and attend a school in Alberta
- All submissions must convey a positive message
- All Grades: original art only, limit of one entry per person

Photographs

- Photos must be a minimum 1MB, suitable for printing at 5" x 7", and be submitted in jpeg format
- **Internet images will be disqualified**, digital photos should be date/time stamped

Posters

- Posters must incorporate creative and original artwork and ideas. Cartoon, video game, movie/television characters and any copyrighted material will not be considered as original and cannot be used in the poster
- Submissions of original art must be a minimum of 11" x 17" and maximum of 24" x 36". Posters must be on white poster paper, larger or smaller entries will not be accepted. Posters should not be laminated
- Any media may be used (watercolor, pen and ink, collage, markers etc.) however, posters must be flat, not 3-D
- For privacy issues please do not place any information such as name, age or school on the front of the poster

Submissions become property of Environmental Artworks Foundation of Alberta (EAFA).
Submissions will not be returned. The EAFA retains the right to use any items submitted for promotional purposes. Winning entries will appear on the Environmental Artworks site, www.artworksalberta.org.

Judging

Submissions will be judged on originality, composition, quality and relevance to the theme.

Artworks reserves the rights to all artwork submitted.

Please submit entries in (only) one of the following categories

Grades 4-6 students are encouraged to submit an 11" x 17" poster.
Hand drawn only, no computer imaging.

Grades 7-9 and 10-12 students are encouraged to submit in the following two categories: Photo and Original Art.

Only one entry per student.

Prizes

Grades 4-6, Grades 7-9 and Grades 10-12

Winners in each category will receive:

- 1st Place: \$500 RESP contribution
- 2nd Place: \$250 RESP contribution
- 3rd Place: \$100 RESP contribution
- The schools of each 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winner will also receive a matching donation to be used where they see fit in the following areas: hot lunch program, recycling program, art or science program.

Grades 4 - 6 School Participation Prize

The Environmental Artworks Foundation of Alberta will organize and host a presentation by Brian Keating from Going Wild at the school with the highest participation.
